Concept

India's scientific wisdom has been recognized globally and India continues to be a treasure trove especially when it comes to India's scientific heritage and scientific advancements. In the recent years, India has been making immense progress in the field of science and technology including medicine, astronomy, mathematics, agriculture, metallurgy, architecture, etc. Nevertheless, India's scientific wisdom has not been adequately communicated or disseminated. Over the period, many a times, miscommunications owing to various factors have resulted in misconceptions to many of our scientific heritage works. Effective communication of India's scientific wisdom can play a very important role in not only enhancing the visibility but also in promoting correct understanding. In the present age with the information explosion, there is a need for assessment of infinite scientific knowledge that has exploded in public domain, use of various cotemporary media, institutionalized mechanisms for communicating India's scientific wisdom and also to build newer initiatives for enhanced scientific knowledge. The 17th Indian Science Communication Congress aims at engaging in narratives around India's scientific wisdom, assessing the current status of communicating India's scientific wisdom and deliberating on the ways and means of communicating India's scientific wisdom to the global audience and thereby shaping the worldview.

ISCC Format

The scientific sessions will have presentation of contributory research papers, review papers, survey analyses, case studies, posters, and invited talks. Deliberations will be in English and/ or in Hindi. The prescribed time for paper presentation will be around 10 minutes (7 minute for presentation + 3 minute for discussion). Power Point presentation facility will be available.

Who can participate

Researchers and practitioners of science communication, i.e. scientists, technologists, academicians, writers, journalists, editors, scholars and faculty members, public relations and information officers of scientific organizations, representatives of media, science activists from NGOs, and senior government officials/ public representatives, policymakers, decision makers from India and abroad can participate.
